Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Fisheries against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. The regulations concern subsistence, commercial, and sport fisheries in the Arctic, Yukon, and Kuskokwim areas. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Fisheries after the close of the public comment period.

Based upon our review, we were unable to approve the Board's proposed change to 5 AAC 01.249(1) under AS 44.62.060(b)(2) and (b)(3) due to vagueness and insufficient statutory support for addition of the words "and traditional knowledge."

We did not find any legal issues with the remainder of the regulation changes. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations.

The September 24, 2025 public notice and the December 11, 2025 certification order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060, including a conforming amendment to 5 AAC 71.010(b). The corrections are incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations.
