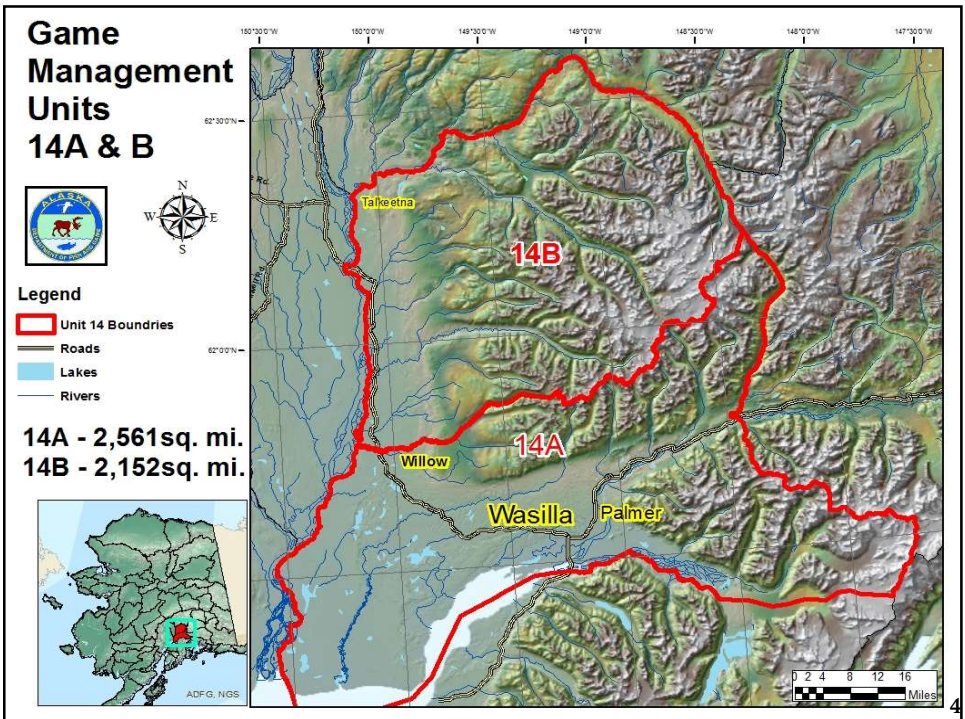

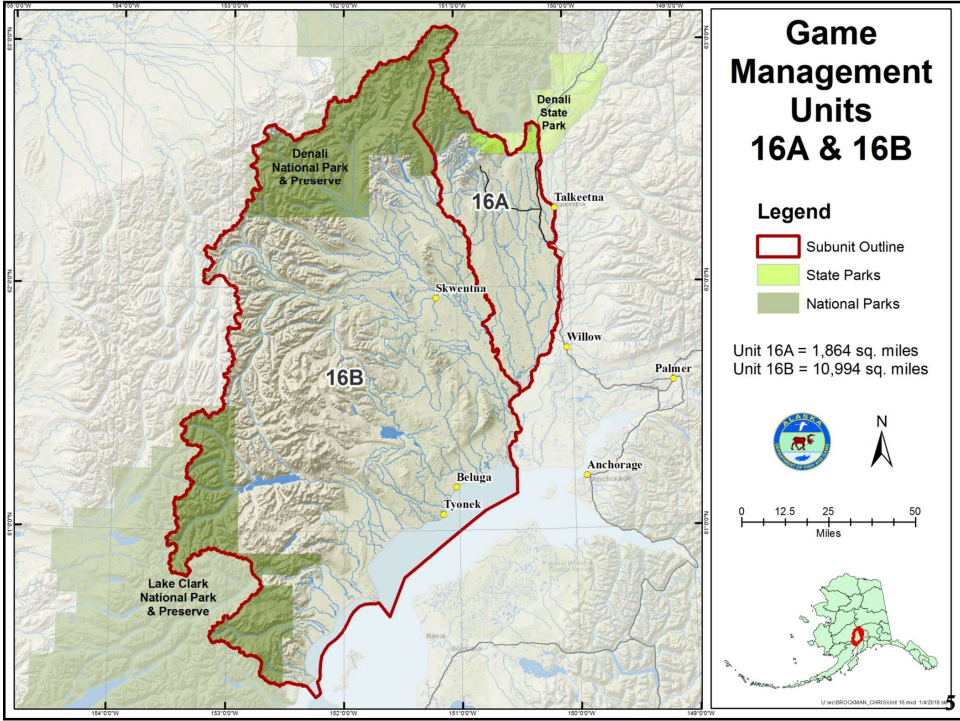
Palmer Area Office

Moose



- **Moose are the species of greatest public interest**
- **Combined 5-year average harvest from Units 14A, 14B, 16A& 16B: 1,186 moose per year**
- **Moose mortality from vehicles & trains averages above 300 annually**
- **Reports of winter killed moose and nuisance moose were down in the spring of 2023**

Moose (continued)



- **Most Units are within or near the population objectives**
 - 16A&B are at the lower end of their objectives
 - 14B is below its objective
 - 14A is slightly above its objective
- **Bull to cow ratios are good in all units except 16B-middle which is low**
- **Harvest in 2023 was within objective in 14A and below in 14B, 16A, & 16B**

- **Unit 14A Population: 6,657 (\pm 810)**
 - Objective 6,000–6,500 moose
- **Unit 14B Population: 1648 (\pm 156)**
 - Objective 2,500–2,800 moose
- **Unit 16A Population: 3,595 (\pm 287)**
 - Objective 3,500–4,000 moose
- **Unit 16B Population: 6,789 (\pm 852)**
 - Objective 6,500–7,500 moose

Dall Sheep



Unit 14A Chugach

- **2023 Minimum Count**
 - 482 Sheep = 267 ewes, 72 lambs, & 142 rams (13 full-curl)
- **Approx. 200 fewer than 2020**
- **Draw hunt (full-curl ram)**
- **Permits reduced from 53 to 14, now to 22**
- **5-year average harvest = 10 rams**

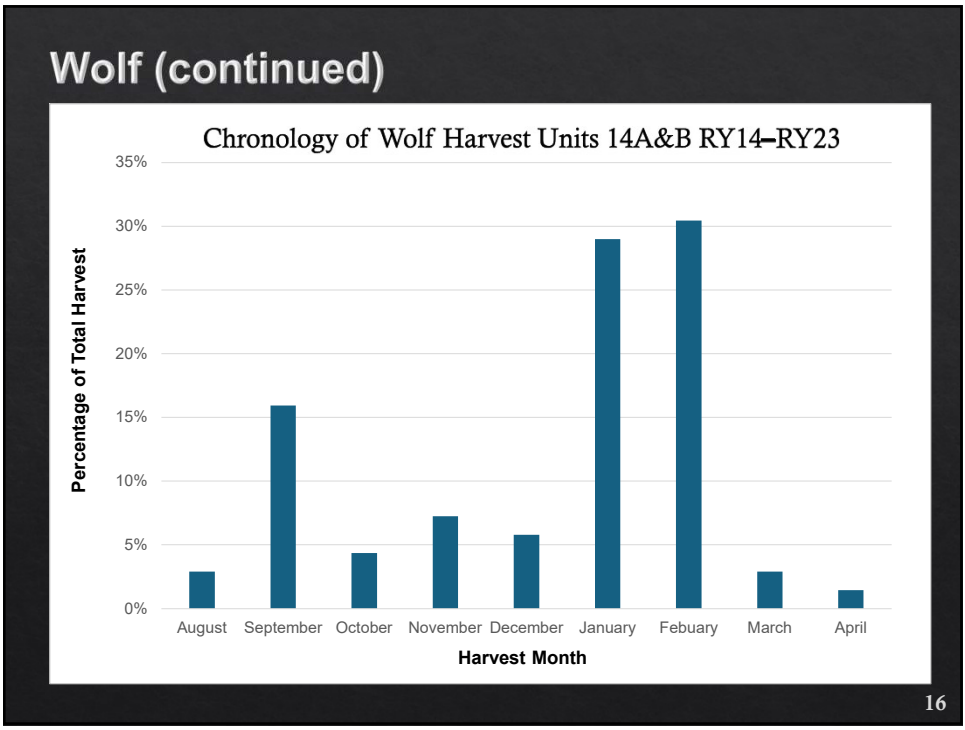

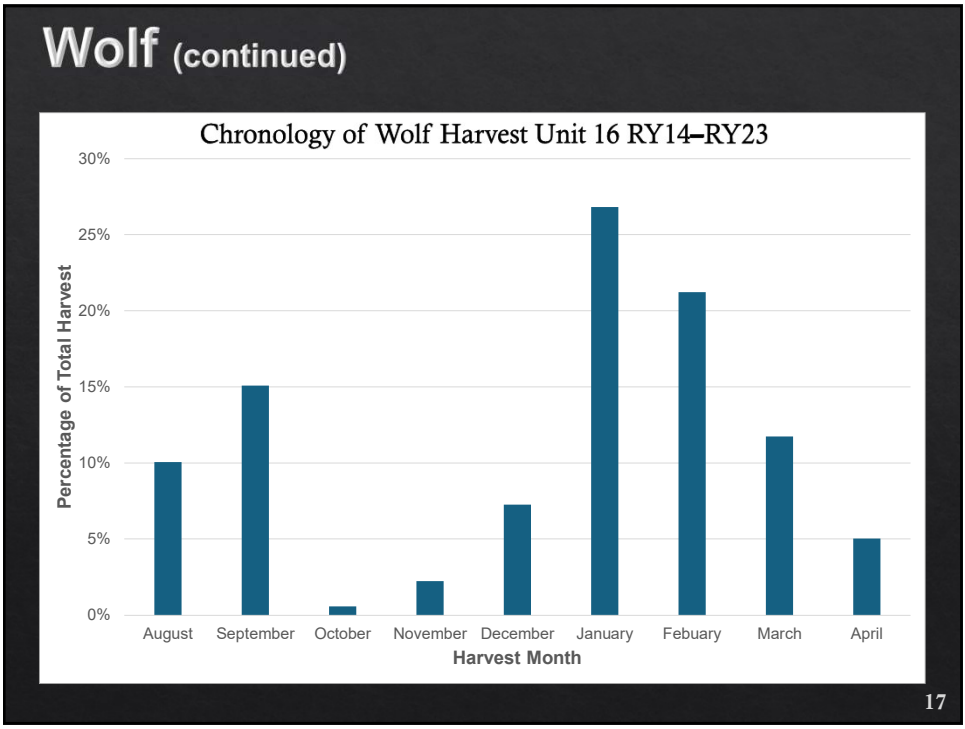
- Unit 14A&B harvest indicates stable or increasing population

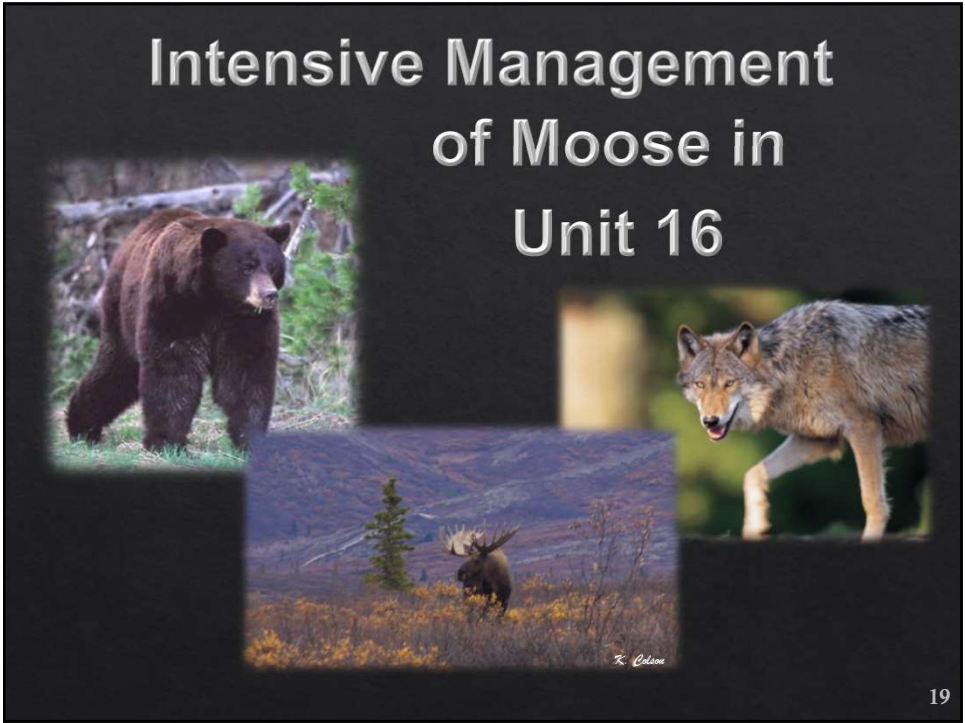

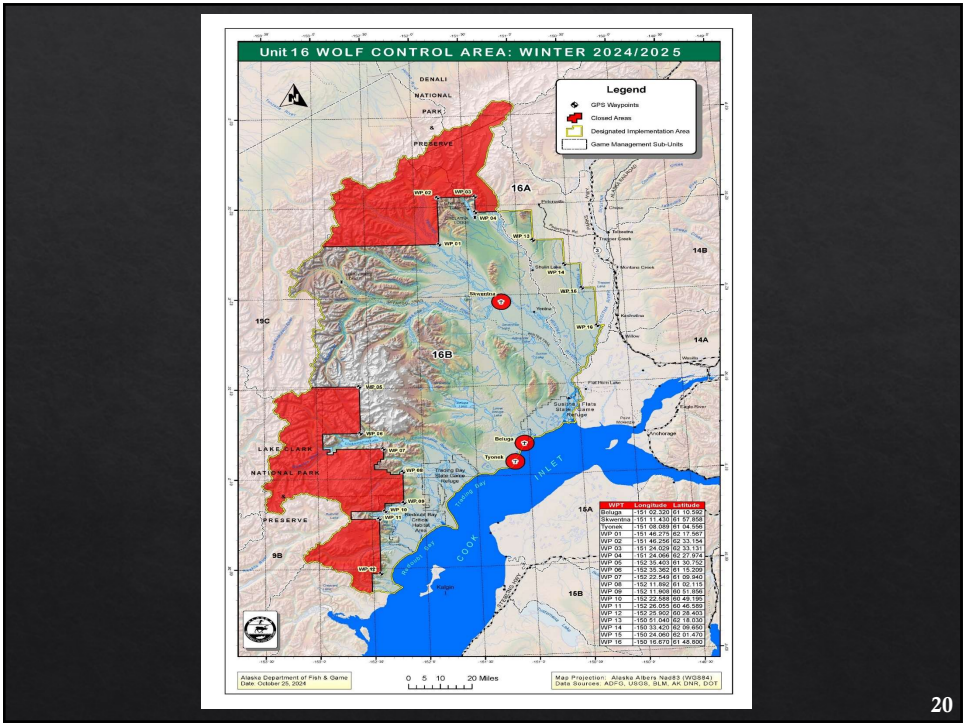

Intensive Management Objectives for Wolves In Unit 16B

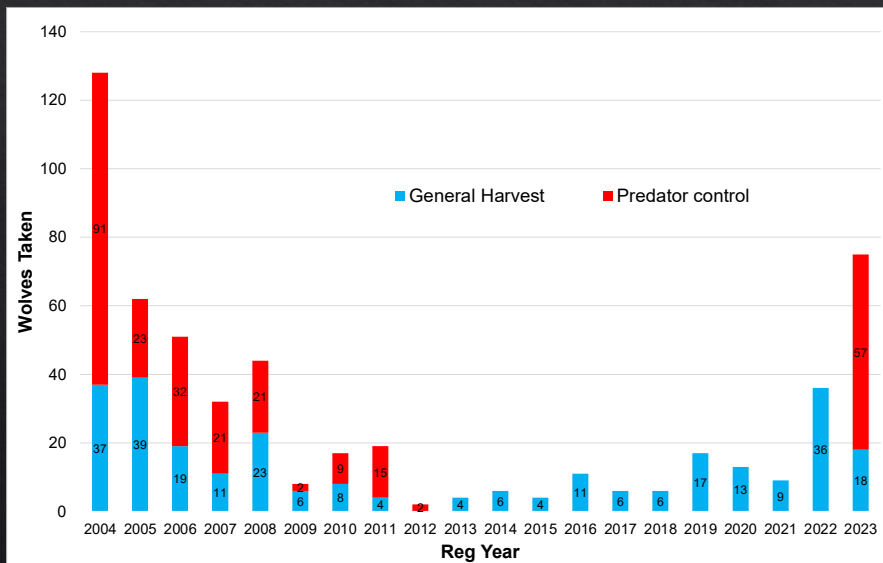
- **Objective: reduce the spring wolf population to 35–55 wolves**

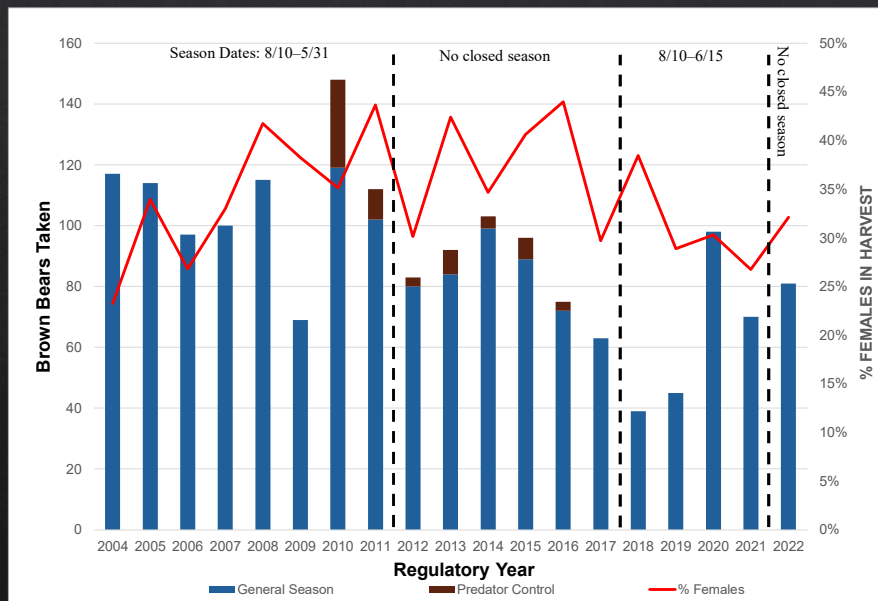

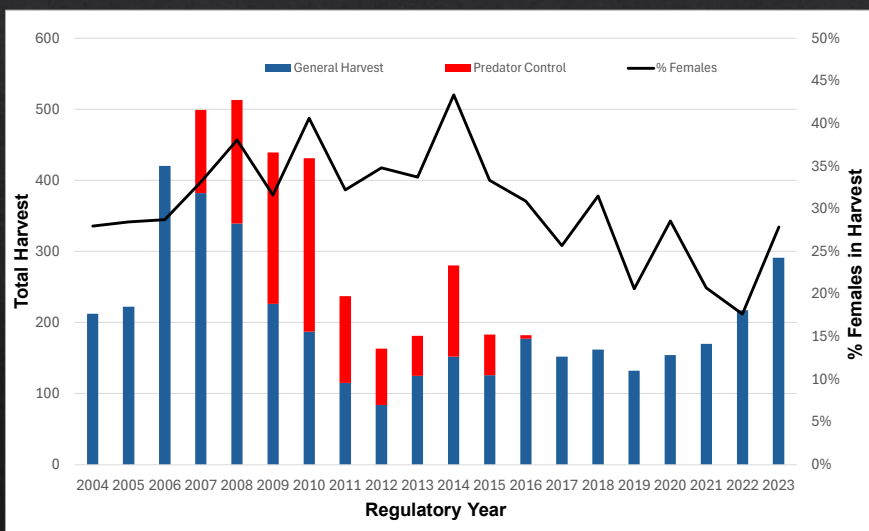
